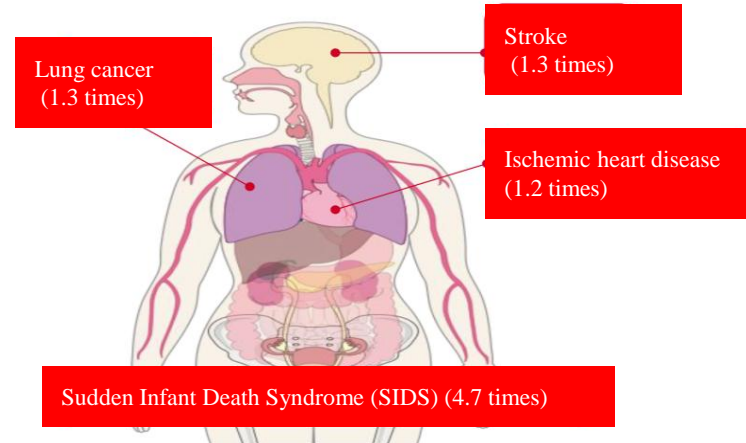
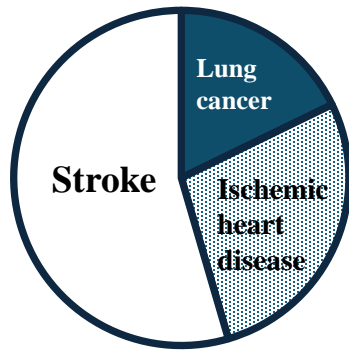
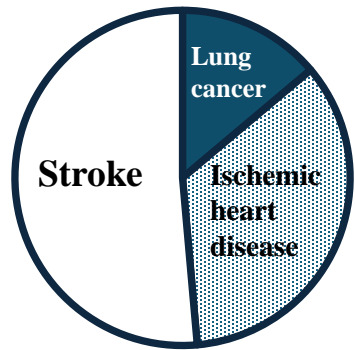
In Japan, the estimated annual number of deaths due to second-hand smoking is about 15,000
